
Space builds our environment, space helps us to create and express an original identity, space holds the relationships we share with ourselves and one another. Space is where we feel, think, interact.









My practice as a photographer and filmmaker, as a storyteller, is marked by the selves that people, places and things portray to me in brief instances.
































































I was born and raised in Cologne, Germany. Inspired by the art scene in the city from an early age, my photographic practice developed from my attempt to speak with and understand other people.
